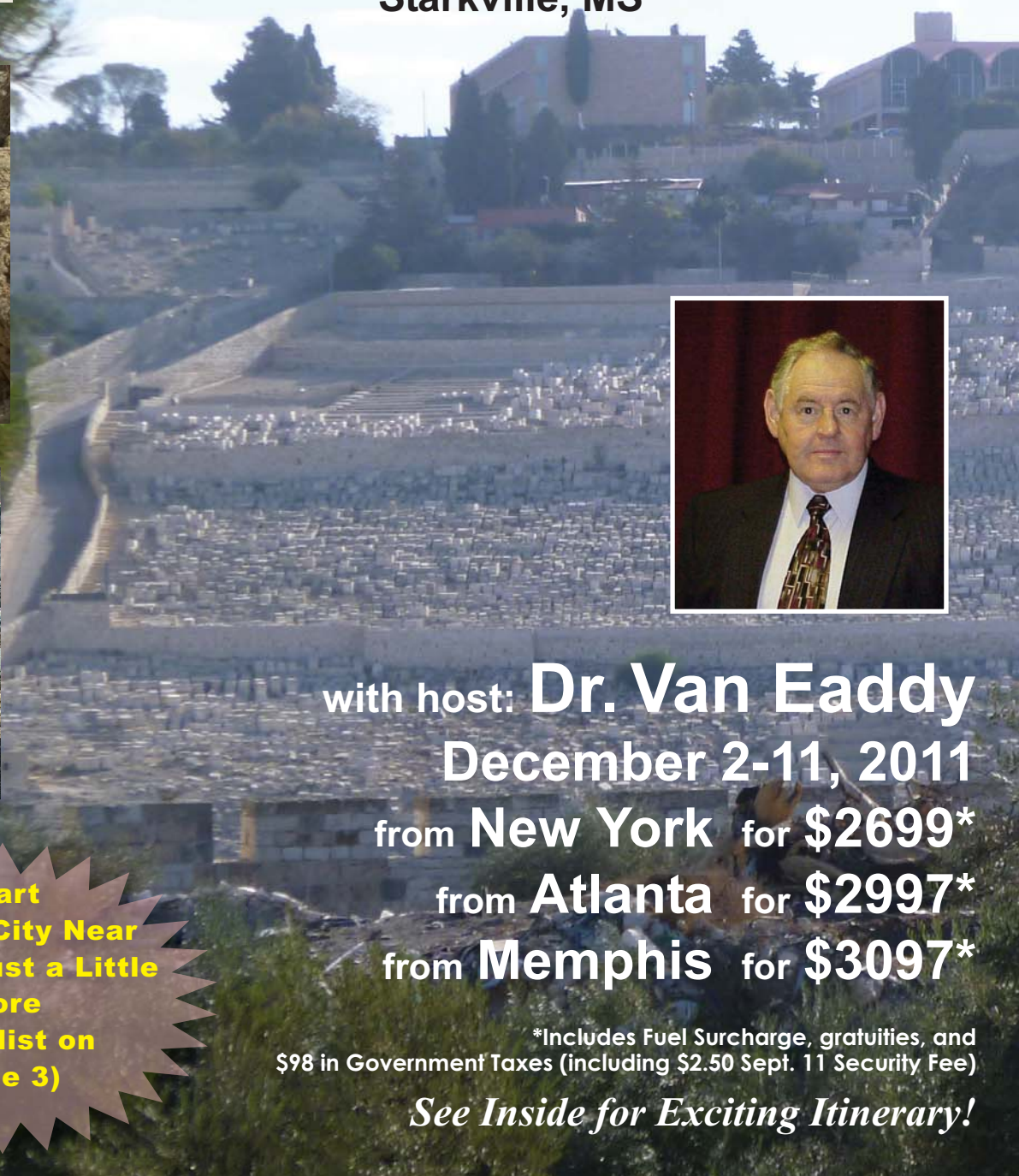

DAY 1 TRANSATLANTIC FLIGHT TO TEL AVIV

Today we depart from the USA to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals served in flight.

DAY 2 ARRIVE IN ISRAEL

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv and transfer to our hotel in the Galilee area for check in, dinner and a good night's sleep.

DAY 3 SEA OF GALILEE / CHORAZIM / CAPERNAUM / MT. OF BEATITUDES / TABGHA / KURSI / BOAT RIDE / JORDAN RIVER

After enjoying the Israeli buffet breakfast, we spend most of our day around the Sea of Galilee. Walk the streets of Chorazim, listed as a "city of woe" by Jesus (Matthew 11). Enter the 2,000 year old remains of Capernaum (Luke 4) and stand in what is left of the synagogue in which our Lord ministered. Visit the traditional site where Jesus preached His Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5-7) and Tabgha, believed to be the place where Jesus fed the 5,000 from the two fish and the five loaves of bread (Mark 6). Continue to Kursi, which was in the region of the Gadarenes in Christ's time, and remember where Christ cast the demons into the swine (Mark 5). After a fish lunch, enjoy a beautiful boat ride across the Sea of Galilee and then stop at the Jordan River for a time of spiritual blessing.

DAY 4 CAESAREA PHILIPPI / DAN / NIMROD'S CASTLE / GOLAN HEIGHTS / PEACE OVERLOOK

After our delicious buffet breakfast, journey to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter proclaimed, "You are the Christ" (Matthew 16). You will also visit the ancient remains of Tel Dan and the altar built by King Jeroboam I (I Kings 12). Visit Nimrod's Fortress that graces the slopes of Israel's highest mountain, Mount Hermon. The fortress overlooks the forested dales and magnificent landscape of the area. Travel through portions of the Golan Heights to gain a better understanding of its strategic importance to the nation of Israel.

DAY 5 GIDEON'S SPRING (HAROD) / NAZARETH OVERLOOK / MEGIDDO / MT. CARMEL / CAESAREA / JERUSALEM

Stop at Gideon's Spring (Harod), where God chose his army of 300 to face the Midianites (Judges 7). See the top of Mt. Carmel, where Elijah prayed down the fire from heaven and defeated the 450 prophets of Baal (I Kings 18). See Nazareth, the boyhood home of Jesus from atop the Nazareth Ridge. Visit Megiddo and the Valley of Armageddon (Rev. 16). Look out over the Valley of Jezreel from the heights of Mount Carmel. On this mount, Elijah defeated the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Wonder at the Roman Aqueduct and Theatre at Caesarea, a center of the early Christians. Here, Cornelius became the first Gentile convert to the new covenant (Acts 10) and Paul was imprisoned before being taken to Rome for trial (Acts 23). Dinner and overnight in our hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 6 MT. ZION / UPPER ROOM / KING DAVID'S TOMB / YAD VASHEM / CAIAPHAS' HOUSE / TREASURES OF THE TEMPLE MUSEUM / RABBI'S TUNNEL

A very full day of sightseeing is planned today. Travel to Mount Zion and stand in the Upper Room, revered as the place of the Last Supper (Mark

14). View the site of King David's Tomb. Visit the Yad Vashem Museum for a somber reminder of the horrors of the holocaust with the purpose of never allowing this portion of history to repeat itself. Next stop is the house of Caiaphas, who was the High Priest at the time of Jesus' trial and crucifixion. See the Treasures of the Temple Museum and view replicas of the instruments used for worship and sacrifice. Experience traveling back in time when walking through the Rabbi's Tunnel, where foundation stones and other stone work survives from the Second Temple!

DAY 7 MASADA / QUMRAN / EIN GEDI / DEAD SEA SWIM

We spend our time in the Judean Wilderness today, as we journey along the shores of the Dead Sea to Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod. Masada is famous as being the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress. Peer down upon the 2,000 year old remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Visit Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to discuss the mysterious community of Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. Journey to the oasis of Ein Gedi, where David and his men sought refuge from Saul (1 Samuel 23). While in the area, we will stop at the Dead Sea where those who desire may take a quick dip in the salt and mineral laden waters, before returning to our hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 8 BETHLEHEM / MT. OF OLIVES / SITE OF THE ASCENSION / GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE

Begin our day of sightseeing in Bethlehem, birthplace of our Lord (Luke 2). Time for sightseeing and shopping will be allowed while in this historic city. Then return to Jerusalem. Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the "Golden City" of Jerusalem, including the Temple Mount and Dome of the Rock. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1). Visit the Chapel of the Ascension. Pray in the Garden of Gethsemane as Jesus prayed (Matt. 26).

DAY 9 WESTERN WALL / POOL OF BETHESDA / OLD CITY / MODEL CITY-SHRINE OF THE BOOK / GARDEN TOMB / GORDON'S CALVARY / TRANSFER TO AIRPORT

Our final day in Jerusalem might be our most memorable. Touch a part of Herod's Temple as we pray at the Western Wall. Walk through the Old City and visit the Pool of Bethesda (John 5), and enjoy the preserved, ancient culture found in the narrow streets of the Old City and the modernized Cardo in the Jewish Quarter. Visit and learn from viewing an outstanding model of Jerusalem as the city appeared 2,000 years ago. The Shrine of the Book Museum houses artifacts and replicas of the famous Dead Sea Scrolls. Also planned today is a stop at Gordon's Calvary where we can sense the agony of Christ's crucifixion and the exhilaration and reality of the resurrection at the Garden Tomb. At the end of our time in the Holy Land, prepare for our return journey to the USA.

DAY 10 ARRIVE USA

Arrive in the USA with a lifetime of memories to cherish.
